The Distinction between Happiness and JOY

JOY is lasting because it is based on God's presence within us.

Even amidst gut wrenching struggles we can have JOY. This happens when we focus on Him.

Matthew 7:7-8

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened

Digging into the Word of God

Spend some time reading Philippians. Paul faced excruciating poverty, abundant wealth and everything in between. His life was hard. He was beaten, imprisoned, persecuted and constantly living in danger and yet, Paul had JOY in every circumstance. Paul learned to be content because he focused all his attention and energy into knowing Christ and obeying Him.
